	<p><b>Burrard View</b>          Surface: quick dry          Painted: no          Status: Courts are in decent shape. However, due to surface, can be dangerous.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 5 &amp; Type 5          # of courts: 2</p>
	<p><b>Champlain</b>          Surface: asphalt          Painted: no          Status: No major cracks. In good area, close to community centre.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 1 &amp; Type 4          # of courts: 4</p>
	<p><b>Captain Cook</b>          Surface: asphalt          Painted: no          Status: Cracks on all courts, strong root invasion. Trees can be trimmed to avoid debris.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 3 &amp; Type 4          # of courts: 2</p>
	<p><b>Garden Park</b>          Surface: asphalt          Painted: yes, blue &amp; green          Status: Nice courts. Leaf fall from nearby trees, and sand kicked/blown onto the courts from adjacent playground, may occasionally need sweeping up.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 1 &amp; Type 3          # of courts: 2</p>
	<p><b>Grandview Park</b>          Surface: asphalt          Painted: no          Status: Courts are somewhat usable. Relatively flat. High user potential if cleaned and painted.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 2 &amp; Type 4          # of courts: 3</p>
	<p><b>Greys Park</b>          Surface: asphalt          Painted: no          Status: Would need re-surfacing. Cracks and root invasion. Cracking on top of patches. Unplayable.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 4 &amp; Type 4          # of courts: 3</p>
	<p><b>Hastings Community Park</b>          Surface: asphalt          Painted: no          Status: No major cracks or root invasion. Great opportunity for lights, as no residences nearby. Hastings Community Centre is within a block.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 2 &amp; Type 4          # of courts: 3</p>
