	<p>John Hendry (Trout Lake) Surface: asphalt Painted: yes Status: Newly repaired and painted, after having been occupied by construction equipment for new ice rink. The practice wall that the old rink provided is now gone.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 1 & Type 3 # of courts: 3</p>
	<p>Kaslo Park Surface: asphalt Painted: no Status: No cracks, but very rough surface. Can be dangerous to play on. Located in a residential neighbourhood. Has potential to be very good courts if maintained.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 2 & Type 4 # of courts: 2</p>
	<p>McSpadden Surface: asphalt Painted: yes Status: Refurbished in 2008. Nice courts with centre strap nets. There is a practice wall, but facing the back of one court – cannot be used unless no one is playing!!!!</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 1 & Type 3 # of courts: 2</p>
	<p>New Brighton Surface: asphalt Painted: no Status: No cracks or trees, but courts in desperate need of painting and upkeep. Location is hard to find, down there under the Second Narrows Bridge. 	<p>Pandora Park Surface: asphalt Painted: no Status: Cracking in asphalt. Good drainage and good location.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 3 & Type 4 # of courts: 4</p>
