	<p>Sutcliffe 1-False Creek Community Centre Surface: asphalt Painted: yes Status: Contract pressure washing took all the paint of these last year....(duh). Park Board obliged to repaint this year (2009). Nice courts.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Rating: 1 & Type 3 # of courts: 2</p>
